

COVID-19 TEMPORARY MEASURES COMMITTEE (CTMC)

The two principal functions of the CTMC are to:

1. Operate as the internal dispute-resolution mechanism for disputes in relation to the operation of the EA Variation; and
2. In the case of major change proposals, consider the proposed timeline and method of staff consultation being proposed by the University in advance of that consultation occurring.

The CTMC is to perform these functions within 5 working days, with an unresolved dispute in either case to be referred to the Local Arbitrator for rapid arbitration within a further 5 working days.

The CTMC will comprise 3 University nominees and 3 NTEU nominees (which could include an official of another union in appropriate cases).

The CTMC will be provided with information relevant to the operation of the EA Variation, but cannot deal with disputes regarding the Category A or B thresholds or decisions by the University as to what cost saving measures it intends to implement.
